Description:

It's back, and bigger than ever before... The award winning **FEAR Scream Park** returns this October to celebrate its tenth birthday, in an incredible eleven nights of frights!

About the role:

We're looking for experienced actors with a previous background in management and team leading. A role that is both challenging and rewarding, you will be responsible for the cast and the operation of an attraction, reporting directly into the FEAR Show Manager.

You **must** have one year of experience as a Scare Actor at **FEAR Scream Park** in order to apply for this position.

Requirements:

We're looking for strong, confident individuals with previous experience in team leading and customer service. You must bring high levels of energy to the role and be up for a challenge, taking on responsibilities and supporting the cast. You will ideally have a background in physical theatre and/or a qualification in Drama or Performing Arts, along with experience (or a willingness to work) in extremely physically and mentally demanding environments.

You will need to be flexible and adaptable in your approach to the role and possess a positive, forward-thinking attitude. You must be able to lead the cast and be their first point of call, providing full support and performing in the attraction alongside them.

Responsibilities

- Develop and implement a comprehensive rehearsal plan, training all cast members to perform at a high standard within the attraction.
- Prepare rotas for the duration of the run.
- Be the cast point of contact for actors within your team, answering any questions or queries they may have.
- Work with other departments to ensure a seamless coordination of the event.
- Be flexible and adaptable to change, as and when the event requires this.
- Ensure that the cast are in the correct costume and makeup.
- Lead a 15-minute cast warm-up prior to opening.
- Carry out all duties in accordance with training and instructions given, and maintain health and safety standards for all guests and staff.
- Once the attraction has closed, ensure that the cast leave it clean and tidy.
- Ensure that all costumes are returned, signed in, and properly stored.
- Maintain a clean and tidy Green Room.
- Complete a show report at the end of each shift.

Dates:

Due to the nature of this role, applicants must be 18 or over and have full availability for the whole duration of the contract. This role will require you to work evenings, weekends, and late nights on following dates:

Rehearsals: September 7th, 8th, 21st, 22nd, and October 4th, 5th, and 6th.

Live Nights: October 11th, 12th, 18th, 19th, 20th, 25th, 26th, 27th, 31st, and November 1st and 2nd.

Dress: £85

Live nights: £105 per night
